We focus on youth, orphans and vulnerable children, people living with HIV and AIDS and other diseases such as tuberculosis. The community has started to accept this challenge by helping each other, and, to a certain degree, the stigma towards people living with HIV and AIDS and chronic diseases has been reduced. Moreover, the relationship between the church, the community, the local government and the central government has improved.

The main goal of my organization is to enhance human living with dignity, socially and spiritually. We have reduced illiteracy in our communities through education programs. Many community members also improved their standard of living through our economic strengthening programs (income generating activities) which are implemented alongside our educational initiatives (education in primary schools, secondary schools and vocational training centers). Our HIV/AIDS programs have also given our community members a greater awareness of the pandemic and chronic diseases.
