The focus of my work is to improve household food and income security in the district through environmentally sound agricultural practices.

I provide inputs for maize and soybean farming, trees, and livestock for farmers, 70 percent of whom are women. Crop beneficiaries, especially the women, realized an increase in yields of maize and soybean. Generally beneficiaries have reported improvement in their lives due to reduced hunger, with a majority of people receiving three meals a day.

The main goal of my organization is to work towards improving the living standards of people in the area where we operate. My organization has been engaged in providing agricultural advisory services and community development activities to communities, which has improved food security and the livelihoods of residents. We also provide training in post-harvest management, animal husbandry, composting, gender sensitization as well as cross-cutting issues (malaria and HIV/AIDS). Village savings and loans are introduced to communities and are managed locally.
