I train and build capacity and skills of local communities and write proposals for funds. Out of my passion for women activities I currently handle a project called Greater Opportunity for Rural Women, which has organized 3,000 women. We trained them to take a business approach to soya farming and for women to produce soya beans through the value chain, linkages and networks. They are also trained to be able to blend soya with other foodstuffs for better nutrition.

Our main goal is to work in partnerships for sustainable development. Girl/child education and inclusion is offered in over 2,000 schools and girl-friendly latrines and boreholes have been provided and in some cases we have recruited volunteer teachers. Well over 7,000 women have been empowered socially, politically, and economically through microfinance, training and advocacy.
