I founded the Princess Center in 2003 when I was an undergraduate student at the National University of Mongolia. Prior to March of this year, I worked at the center since its inception as executive director. Now, I work in the policy level of the organization as an advisor, responsible for developing long-term policy and strategic plans, providing technical support to staff members, bringing innovative approaches to its programs and managing the fundraising policy.

The Princess Center in Mongolia is a young women-led organization, founded in 2003 under the initiative of young women majoring in social work, psychology and law. It empowers girls dealing with social problems such as early pregnancy and sexual abuse. It works to protect girls' rights by providing comprehensive social services, raising awareness and doing policy advocacy. The center has 13 years of practical experience working with teenage mothers, survivors of sexual violence and their families.
