

Adult Education

- [Adult Education and Development](#), search available for all articles published in the journal: (1973)-current.
- [Adult Education Quarterly](#), (StFX only), issues available: 1(1950)-current. Includes archive of *Adult Education*.
- [Adult Learning](#), (StFX only), issues available: 10:2(1999)-current.

Some of the journals require your StFX account information to view the contents, and have the note **StFX only**. The remaining journals are Open Access with no log-in required.

Click on a journal title to view the contents. If the journal is **StFX only**, you will see a blue login box to the StFX "Proxy Server". Type your StFX username and password. It is the same login information you use for Moodle. You will then be redirected to the journal homepage and can browse or search the content.

For example, if you click on *Action Research*, and then type your username and password in the blue box, you should see the journal home page. From here, you can browse the featured latest articles, select the current or past issues, or select “Search” tab for the search box to enter your key words :

Each database is a bit different, but most have similar components: An icon to indicate the article is available (here it is an unlocked padlock), an abstract (short description), and option to download the article as a PDF document.
