## **Greetings!**

We are excited to welcome you to Antigonish to <u>Learning with Community</u>, a Canadian Association for the Study of Adult Education (CASAE) conference hosted by Coady Institute and the ENGAGE project, and St. Francis Xavier University. This is the first CASAE Atlantic Regional conference since 2019, and we have an exciting program to look forward to.

In this letter, we share some important information for all participants:

**Location:** All conference sessions will be held in the Markham Global Complex (MGC) and Coady Institute (CI) buildings located on the St. F.X. campus. On both days, conference events begin in the Markham Global Complex. All events on Friday, May 23, are here. On Saturday, May 24, the conference presentations will be here and in Coady Institute.

**Parking:** On Friday May 23<sup>rd</sup> there is free event parking on campus. Connect with the organizers to get your parking pass. Parking is free on campus on Saturdays. Please put the StFX parking pass on your dashboard where Campus Security can see it. The closest parking lot to MGC and Coady Institute is Chapel Square; the next closest is off Convocation Blvd. The overnight parking fee is included in accommodation rates.

If you have mobility issues, note that there is limited accessible parking outside of MGC.

**Staying overnight on campus:** If you booked accommodations on campus, check-in is in Governor's Hall, and accommodations are in O'Reagan and Riley Halls. Click for <u>conference campus map</u>

**Welcome/Registration Desk:** Will be in the MGC foyer Friday from 12:00 to 1:00 pm and on Saturday from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. Please stop by to let us know you have arrived so we can check your name off our registration list, and you can pick up a name tag.

**Registration:** All presenters must be registered and have paid their registration fee by May 16<sup>th</sup> to be included in the program. The last day for registration is May 20<sup>th</sup> for all other participants. We need to know the number of attendees to ensure that we have ordered sufficient catering.

**Meals/Refreshments:** On Friday, at the People's school, there will be a coffee break with light refreshments. On Saturday morning, a continental breakfast will be provided to all participants in Dennis Hall and will be replenished at break time. A vegetarian boxed lunch will also be provided in Dennis Hall from noon to 1:00 p.m.

During this lunch, we encourage you to mingle with other participants and view the poster displays. The presenters are asked to spend some time standing by their posters to answer any questions from other participants about their research.

**Friday Evening Square Dance:** If you want to have a regional Maritime experience, participants are encouraged to check out the local square dance being held at the Maryvale School House Hall, 4 J R S Dr, in Maryvale (NS-245). ## **Paper Presentations and Roundtables**

There will be three at times four concurrent roundtable and paper sessions scheduled for the remainder of Saturday, finishing off by 3:00 p.m, so people will have time to drive home.

Volunteers will chair sessions to ensure that presenters keep within their scheduled time to speak, so that everyone will have a chance to talk about their work and ask questions. Presenters for papers and roundtables have 20 minutes, which includes their presentation and discussion/Q&A on their presentation. There are two presentations in each 45-minute timeslot. It is suggested that roundtable presentations are 10 minutes maximum to have more time for discussion.

Presenters can share slides on the technological equipment in the presentation rooms. For easy transition between presenters who are using slides, it is recommended that presenters arrive early to their session to set up and have their presentations on an USB thumb/flash drive.
